Superangel appeared on Haight St., in the historic Haight Ashbury district, today, in what could only be described

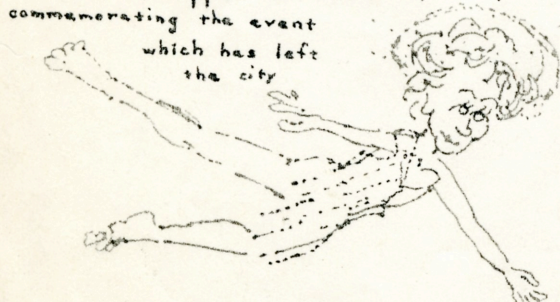

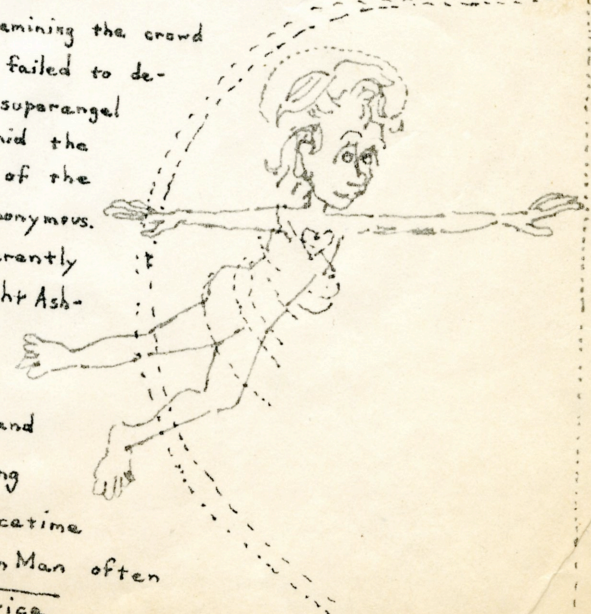
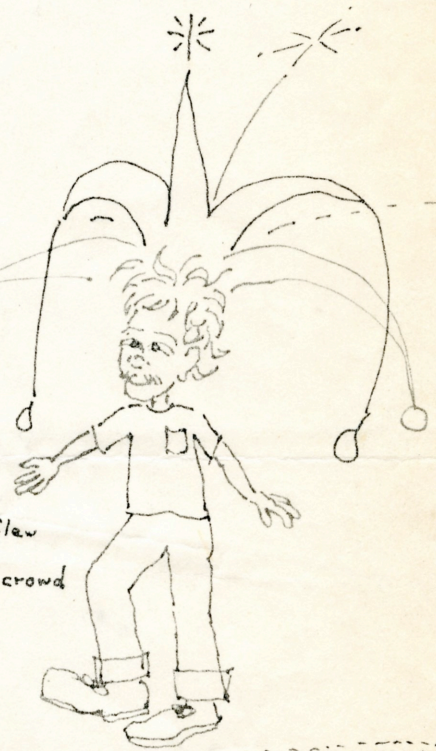
as miraculous by all who witnessed the event.

He then flew heavenward over the top of the grocery store as he warned the crowd below to "BE GOOD, for I am here to help you."

The mayor of SF and the board of supervisors are reportedly examining the possibilities of erecting a 50 foot bronze and copper statue commemorating the event which has left the city forever changed.



Experts, examining the crowd of witnesses, have failed to determine how the superangel managed to live amid the millions of people of the city and remain anonymous. Superangel was apparently working in the Haight Ashbury district as a window washer for 2 years and still completely concealed his real identity. 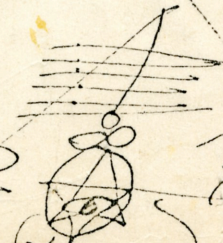
