Pioneer Information Continues to Come

A. E. Conlón, 190 Twenty-seventh avenue, the member of the California Historical Society compiling the early history of the Richmond district, reports the following additional results of the publication of a list of pre-1850 pioneers in The Banner of May 9th:

A telephone call from Mrs. A. Calaguri, 1565 Quesada avenue, granddaughter of John Baker, pioneer of 1850. Her father, the late Adam Baker, was born in 1861 at the Baker's Golden Gate Ranch, on what is now Searcliff. So far as is known, he was the first child born in the district.

A call from Nicholas Nusbaum, 536 Sixteenth avenue. His father, Frederick Nusbaum, moved from downtown to the west side of First avenue between Geary and Clement, in 1886. The property was sold when the Geary Street Railroad built the brick car barn on the northwest corner of First avenue and Geary. The Nusbaum family then moved to 413 Third avenue.

Mrs. V. Wilbur, 494 Thirty-sixth avenue, is the daughter of John Cassidy, pioneer of 1872.
