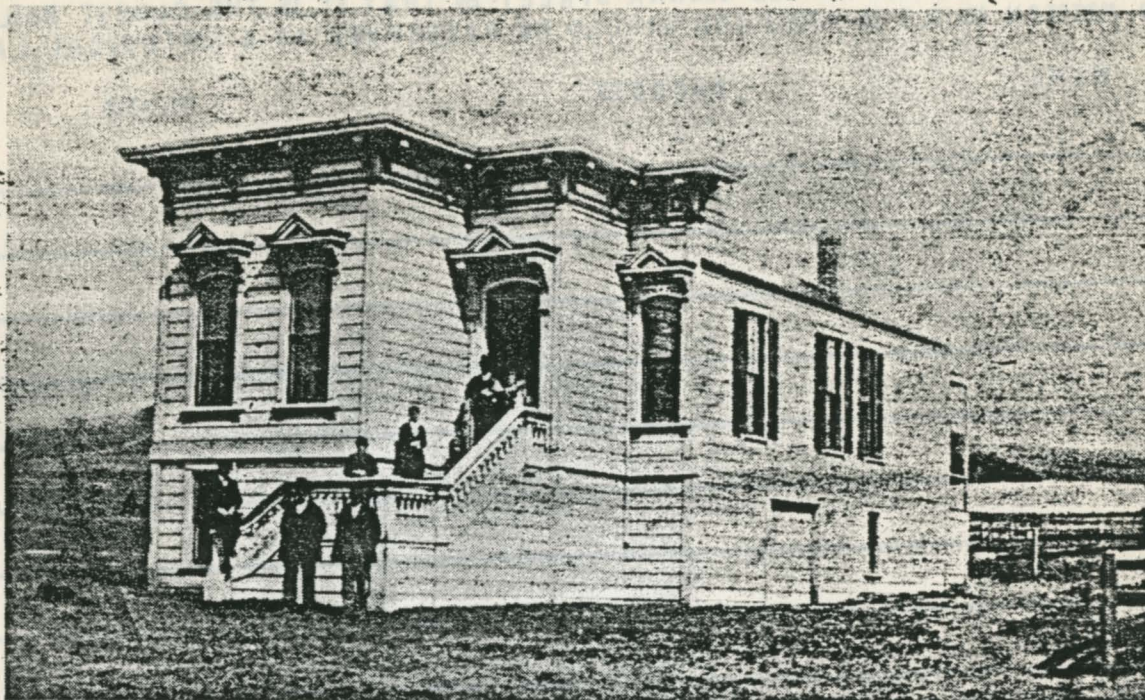


# HOUSE 100 YEARS OLD

This year marks the hundreth year of the house at 503 Vienna Street. It was built in 1880 by Mr. & Mrs. Frank R. Smith. Today, it is occupied by their grandson, Walter Dutcher.



The corner store at Persia and Vienna, adjoining the old house, was built in 1900. In early days this area was known as Excelsior Homestead Association district. The store was also built and operated by Frank R. Smith, then by his son-in-law, Elmer Dutcher. In 1949, the third generation, Walter Dutcher ran the business until it closed in 1973.
