San Francisco Public Library

In November 2000, the voters overwhelmingly passed a bond measure for \$106 million to upgrade San Francisco's branch library system. The Branch Library Improvement Program will provide the public with seismically safe, technologically updated, code compliant and accessible City-owned branch libraries in every neighborhood.

New branch libraries will be built in the Glen Park, Portola, Ingleside, and Visitacion Valley neighborhoods, with groundbreakings scheduled for 2003-05. These branches are currently housed in leased facilities and will be replaced by City-owned buildings. Also, in early 2004 construction will begin on a branch in the new community of Mission Bay.

Excelsior Branch Library

The nineteen branches scheduled to be renovated are: Anza, Bayview/Anna E. Waden, Bernal Heights, Excelsior, Eureka Valley/Harvey Milk Memorial, Golden Gate Valley, Marina, Merced, Noe Valley/Sally Brunn, North Beach, Ortega, Park, Parkside, Potrero, Presidio, Richmond, Sunset, West Portal and Western Addition.

Bond funding does not cover the entire cost of the projects. The Friends of the San Francisco Public Library is raising \$16 million from private donations for furniture, fixtures, and equipment. If you're interested in helping with this campaign, please call 415-437-4859.

The renovation and modest expansion of the Excelsior Branch Library is Phase I of the Branch Library Improvement Program (see back panel for more information). During the last 35 years no significant modifications have been made to the Excelsior Branch Library. It is therefore in need of seismic upgrading, American with Disabilities Act accessibility improvements and infrastructure modernization. Updating the branch will enable the San Francisco Public Library to provide the Excelsior neighborhood with a branch library that is flexible, safe, updated and accessible to all. The estimated total budget for the project is \$3.6 million.
