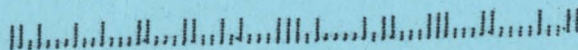

Jewish Home Landscaping Upgrade

You may have noticed that the trees and vegetation have been removed at the Jewish Home. This is preparatory for their new landscaping enhancements being done at the request of the community, which should be completed by the end of the year. It's been kind of interesting to get a good view of the buildings, but new landscaping will be most welcome.

Plans for their construction and renovation project which will include replacement of the east wing (hey, wouldn't that be a great name of a television series!), built in the early 1920s and a new parking garage, are awaiting approval by the statewide Health Planning Development. Assuming approval, construction should begin mid-2004 and will take two to three years. The semi-underground parking lot will be in the final phase of construction.

In the meantime, the community is being treated to lovely new landscaping. Now what do we do about the pigeons that hang out on the corner of Mission and Silver?

Neighborhood Park Planning

Since March of 2000, the Recreation and Park Department has been implementing plans to renovate or restore all of the City's 230 parks and recreation facilities. This capital improvement program is funded through the Neighborhood Park Bond (Prop A), the Open Space Fund (Prop C), State and federal grants, philanthropic gifts and other sources. In the past three years, the program has spent approximately \$71.3 million and initiated or completed 121 capital improvement projects, including the Excelsior Playground.
