COACHES' THOUGHTS

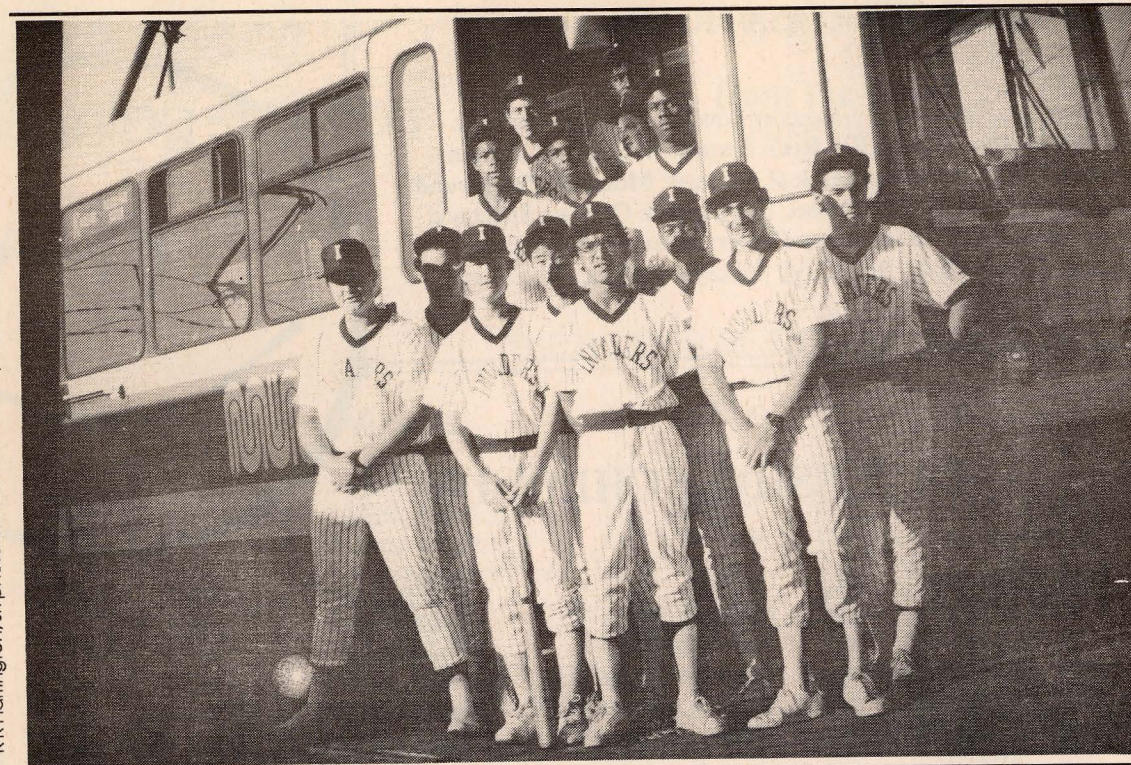
