


## Lake Merced Restoration



Lake merced is located in the southwest corner of San Francisco near Skyline and Lake merced Boulevards. It consists of four inter-connected freshwater lakes North Lake, South Lake, East Lake and Impound Lake that are fed by rain water and seepage from historic springs and creeks. The Lake is a major natural habitat for many species of birds and waterfowl and a regional recreational venue offering fishing, bicycling and wildlife viewing.
