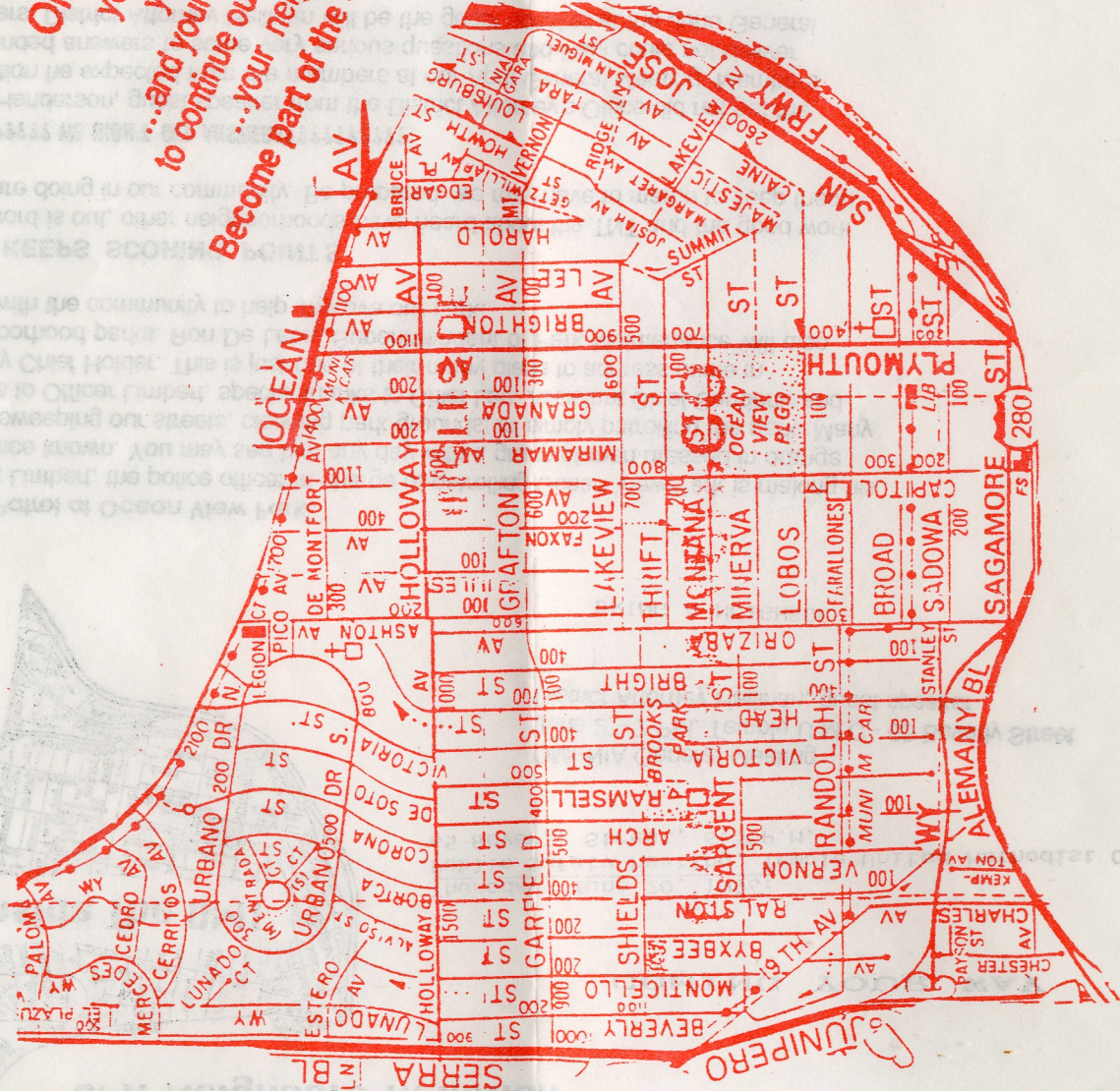

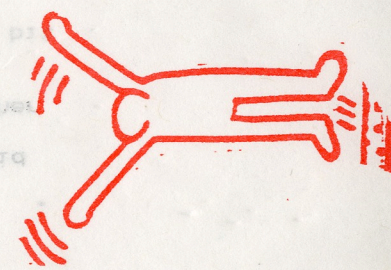

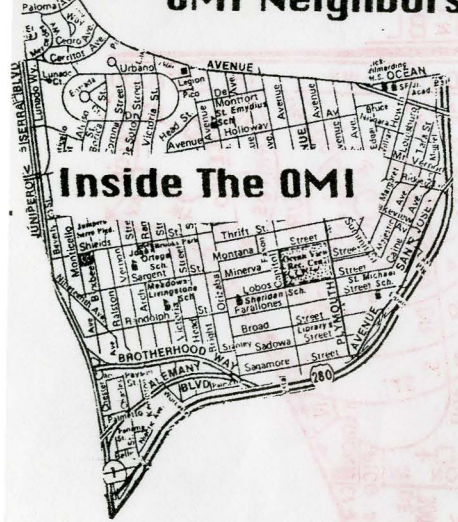
It is also our hope and intent to encourage and foster a better relationship among neighbors. As a group of neighbors helping neighbors, we strive to address problems affecting the OMI community.
