As you may recall, when I was first elected to the Assembly in 1976, I promised to work with my neighbors on Potrero Hill to convince P.G. & E. to remove their natural gas storage tanks in our backyards.

That day is finally here.

P.G. & E. has agreed to remove its storage tank at Army Street and Evans Avenue and announce the removal date of its tank on Pennsylvania Avenue.

To celebrate this occasion, a "demolition ceremony" has been planned for Friday, February 15th beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the facility (please see enclosed map).

Since all of us who make our homes on the Hill have worked so hard and so long for this day, we should all share in this victory celebration.

That's why I take great pleasure in inviting you and your family to this celebration and I encourage you to attend with your neighbors this Friday.



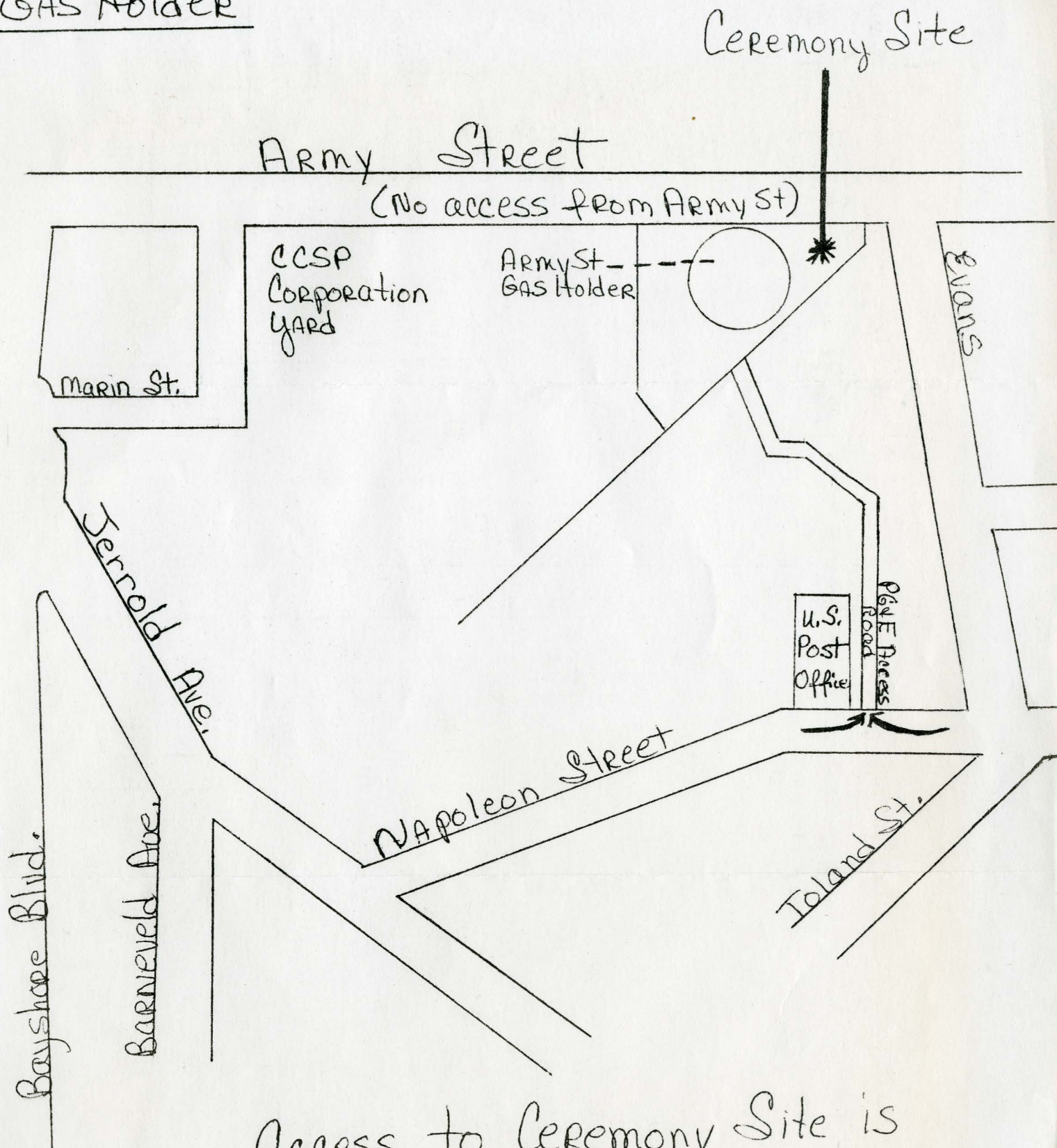
